Across the Interamerican Region

The Interamerican Scout Foundation had a strong and active presence during the **Interamerican Scout Conference**, where it presented an institutional report highlighting the Foundation's growth and key achievements in recent years. The Foundation also participated in the **Night of the Americas** with an institutional booth, creating opportunities to engage with National Scout Organizations and partners.

In addition, the Foundation hosted a **special recognition dinner** for conference participants, honoring new donors and members who advanced their levels within the Order of the Condor. The program also included the **Condor Experience**, offering exclusive activities designed for members of the Foundation's donor community, and concluded with the **Annual Board Meeting**, focused on strategic planning and future priorities for the Foundation.



The Brigitte and Bill Therivel Youth Leadership Development Fund

In 2025, the Interamerican Scout Foundation established the Brigitte and Bill Therivel Youth Leadership Development Fund, honoring the commitment of Brigitte and Bill Therivel to youth development and leadership excellence. The fund supports leadership opportunities for young adults aged 18–26 across the Interamerican Region.

The fund primarily strengthens the Interamerican Leadership Training (ILT) program, an intensive residential experience that brings together 50–80 young leaders each year from across the Americas. Through scholarships, high-quality training, and ongoing development support, this initiative equips emerging leaders with the skills, confidence, and regional perspective needed to create positive change in their communities.

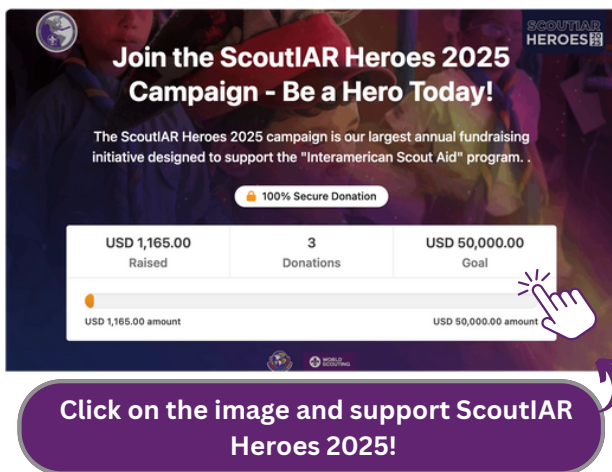
JamCam 2025
